### MEASURING

Any dogs who have shown proof of a permanent height card do not need to be measured. Beyond that, the only dogs that need to be measured are those entered in Proficient Category and are jumping 8", 12" or 16"

### General Directions to MVP Sports Complex, 707 Doc Henry Road, Greenwood, Mo 64034

From the metropolitan Kansas City area:

Coming into Kansas City from any direction – north, south, east or west – you want to travel onto I-470 in Missouri and exit from I-470 onto US-50 E via EXIT 7A toward SEDALIA. You then will travel 2.7 miles going east on US-50 until you exit to the right onto MO-291 S exit toward HARRISONVILLE. You will travel 3.2 miles south on MO-291 until you exit to the right onto MO-150 – the exit ramp heads down a hill. At the stop sign you will turn left; you will head East. In less than a mile you will turn right onto Doc Henry road. Take your time at this turn, it's a bit tight. Then head less than a mile on Doc Henry. The arena will be on your left, set back from the road a bit but you can't miss it.

## SITE INFORMATION

The surface indoors is sports turf. This is the surface that indoor soccer and arena football is played on. It is absolutely flat, with a perfect amount of cushion underneath. There are indoor bathrooms. There will be crating space available inside the arena. We ask, when possible, that crates be stacked. Standard 4' by 4' X-pens will be allowed, but only for use by 2 or more dogs. Some of the crating space that will be used are dance rooms with wooden flooring. These rooms will need to have some type of matting used under the dog's crate/x-pen to protect the floor. We appreciate your compliance with this so we can continue to use this facility.

As with every trial any of us have ever attended picking up after your dog{s} is a handler responsibility and must happen. This is a very nice site and we want to be able to hold many trials here. Please help us in keeping the site clean and as we found it before arriving with lots of dogs.

We hope you come to this show and have a wonderful fun time with your dog{s}. Thanks for your cooperation in these matters.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. All dogs, including Novice are required to have a NADAC registration number in order to enter a trial. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial. The safety of

the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Refunds will be made for bitches that come in season after the closing dates (Less Administrative Fee). Handler must present a Vet Certificate before the show starts. Refund of entry fees before the closing date will be charge an administrative fee of \$25.00/dog entered. Refund of entry fees after the closing date will be charge an administrative fee of \$35.00/dog entered.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site.

Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

No food, toys or devices of any kind are permitted on the course. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in being excused from the ring.

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the [NADACagility@yahoo.com](mailto:NADACagility@yahoo.com) list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as

reported by the club, are correct. You can join the [www.NADACAgility@yahoo.com](mailto:www.NADACAgility@yahoo.com) list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

- .1 As used here “NADAC” means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- .2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- .3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to person, dogs, or property and that the entered dog’s rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- .4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these any harm arising from these.
- .5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC & U2 Kan Du Agility {including its officers, directors and members, and event organizing committee, MVP Sports Complex {including its officers, Agents, and employees} and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises.
